This Township is a generally E. slope  
 slightly rolling, rising about the  
 western part over rolling hills to the  
 Summit of the White River mountains  
 which in this part are low. The  
 Township abounds in bunch grass -  
 It is also timbered with cedar pine  
 and mahogany - A good deal of  
 white sage occurs in places along the  
 Eastern border. There are Springs in  
 Sections 4, 8, 9, 16, 17, 33
