The Eastern and Southern portion  
of this township, being broken by a  
high barrow range of mountains  
beginning at the cor. bldcs 19. 24. 25. 30  
on the West boundary and run thence

Each on true line between 19 & 30  
Lat 37° 30' E

Ascent gradual slope.

3y. 25 Set a trap stone 13x9x5, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ . 8 in  
in ground, in mound of stones for a  
sec cor, having made allowance for the  
convergency which would arise in  
running North from the 5th Standard  
parallel North

77. 25 Set a flint stone 20x12x10. 40 in in ground  
in mound of stones, marked 3 notches  $\frac{3}{4}$  in  
5 E. for cor bldcs 19. 20. 29. 30
