

General Description

In Range 46 E. this standard line passes over the Toquima Range of mountains, which are high and in some places rough.

There is some scattering Pinon and juniper timber, but its growth is not large. In Rgs 47 East, the line crosses Monitor valley which contains fair soil, with a fine growth of white sage and bunch grass and is suitable for cultivation or grazing. In Rgs 48 E. the line ascends over a gentle west slope of the mountain base, for the first mile, but is prevented from being extended through the range, by the extreme roughness of the mountains.
