Mount-Diablo Base<sup>and</sup> Meridians

Began December 30<sup>th</sup> 1875 at the  
Standard Corner to Township 26 North  
Ranges 42<sup>and</sup> 43 East on the 5<sup>th</sup>  
Standard Parallel North, <sup>and</sup> run thence  
along said Standard in Range 43 East  
having ascertained the Variation by  
observation on Polaris to be  $16^{\circ} 52' E$   
East, on South Boundary Sec. 31  
Var.  $16^{\circ} 52' E$

- 40.00 Lava Porphyry Stone  $14 \times 7 \times 6$  in,  $8^{\frac{1}{2}}$  in  
ground, with pits  $24 \times 18 \times 12$  in, marked  
 $\frac{1}{4}$  for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor.
- 73.60 Lower Stage road from Battle Mountain  
to Austin N<sup>and</sup> E.
