- 39,96 Set cedar Post,  $3 + 3$  inches,  $\frac{1}{4}$  feet long with chard stake 1 foot deep. Raised mound of earth 24 inches high. Sink pits  $12 + 12 + 24$  inches marked  $\frac{1}{4} S$ , for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section corner.
- 79,96 Intersected corner to sections 3, 4, 9 & 10, Rough Hill, Pinon & Cedar timber Limestone formation soil 2" rate

Beginning at the  $\frac{1}{4}$  Section corner, between sections 16 & 17, which I find to be a post, marked  $\frac{1}{4}$ , mound and pits, thence running north on true line between sections 16 & 17.

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
