

Pyramid Reservation

Field Notes of Survey retracing
a part of the Western Boundary
of the Pyramid Lake Indian
Reservation in the State of
Nevada

Begin November 15th 1878
On the Summit of a Round Red
Peak about $2\frac{1}{4}$ miles S of W of
the town of Madsworth known
as the Red White & Blue Mountain
& identified by settlers in the
vicinity who were present when
the survey was made by E. Monroe,
where I found a large monument
of rocks, whence the corner to
Sec. 5-6-7 and 8 of Township
20 North Range 24 East bears
 $S 6\frac{1}{4}^{\circ} E 20\frac{1}{2}^{\circ} 84^{\circ}$ dist. & run
thence, retracing the boundary
of said Reservation as surveyed +
