I find it impossible to run the West
 Boundary of this township as the line
 passes over very high impassable
 rocky mountains through which
 there are a number of deep precipi-
 tous ravines and perpendicular
 bluffs. and in order to establish
 the South boundary I begin at
 the Corner to T. 44. 45 N R. 24. 25
 E. M. D. M. previously established
 (having ascertained the variation
 of the magnetic needle by an
 observation on Polaris to be 18.00 E
 and also find the Corner standing
 as originally set a trap stone
 20.128. with pits 12.12.24. 6 notches
 S and E and run
 E. on true line on S. bdy. Sec. 31
 Var. 18° E

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
