 North to be 3.11 chs. East for  
 each range West of the Carson  
 guide Meridian.

 of the established Cn to T<sup>h</sup> 35 N  
 Rs. 19. 20. E. on Standard line.

Set chanced post 4 1/2 ft. long 4.4  
 12 in in ground dig 3 pits 12, 12, 24,  
 raise earth mound 3 ft. high 6 ft.  
 diam. Mk. T<sup>h</sup> Rs. Secs. 6 notches N  
 E and W for Cn to T<sup>h</sup> 36 N Rs. 19
