Along South Slope.

10.50 Descend.

37.50 Cross Gulch, 20 lks. wide, Course S. 25 N. and ascend.

40.00 After diligent search, being unable to find old corner, I  
Set temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.

84.20 To a point 96 lks. North of  
The Cor. to Tps. 20 & 25 N. Rs. 18 & 19 E.  
which I find nearly destroyed I establish same and  
Set Volcanic Stone  $\frac{1}{6} \times \frac{1}{4} \times \frac{1}{2}$ , in Stone mound  
 $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. in diameter at base, by 2 ft. in height, for cor.  
to Tps. 20 & 25 N. Rs. 18 & 19 E.

The return course is therefore N.  $89^{\circ}21'$  E.
