 8 lks. East for "4 sec. cor.

79.88 To a point 13 lks. East of old section
 corner, which I find nearly destroyed;
 I rebuild same, and set Post, in
 Earth mound, $4 \frac{1}{2}$ ft. in dia. at base,
 by 2 ft. in height and dug pits,
 $24 \times 18 \times 12$, 8 lks. dist. at 4 angles,
 for corner to sections 1-6-7-12.
 The return course is therefore N. 6' E.,
 and level.
