Chains.

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this T. I made a change of 15 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by subtracting same from the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing.

From the ^{Standard} Cor. to Tps. 20 S. Rs. 62 & 63 E.

I run,

North on a true line between sections 31 & 36.

Va. 15° 25' East.

Ascend.

40.00 Set a sand stone 22 x 11 x 8 ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a sand stone 25 x 14 x 10 ins. 18 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 30-31-25-8 (marked with / notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
