Set a Sandstone, 17 x 12 x 9 ins., 11 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 on W. face, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. E. and W. of stave, 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base.

Intersect 4th Standard line S., 18.00 chs. W. of Standard Cor. to Secs. 31 & 32, T. 16 S., R. 64 E. and set a Sandstone, 17 x 11 x 9 ins., 11 ins. in the ground, for closing Cor. to Secs. 5 & 6, marked with 5 notches on E. and 1 notch on W. edges, dug pits 18 x 18 x 12 ins. S., E., & W. of stave, 5 1/2 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, 2 ft. high, 4 1/2 ft. base.

Vegetation of sagebrush and bunchgrass.
