40.00 Set a sand stone 16 x 12 x 9 ins. 10 ins. in the ground for 1/2 sec. 10 or marked 1/2 on N. face, dug hole, 18 x 18 x 18 ins. around N. of stone 1/2 ft. dist. and paved a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high 3 1/2 ft. base.

76.71 Intersect the 4th Standard Parallel south at a point 14.55 chs. West of the Standard 10 or. to Secs. 34 and 35 T. 16 S. R. 62 W. at which point I

Set a sand stone 28 x 18 x 15 ins. 2 ins. in the ground for closing cor. to Secs. 34 and 35 marked C. C. with 2 notches on C. and 4 notches on N. sides and paved a mound of stone pits impracticable.
