76.48 Intersect the 1/2 Standard Parallel South at a point 13.18 chs West of the Standard Cor. to Secs. 3 and 8, T. 16. S. R. 62 W. at which point

Set a sand stone 28 x 16 x 9 ins, 2 1/2 ins in the ground for clearing pegs to Secs. 5 and 6 marked C. C. with 5 notches on C, and 1 notch on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pit's impracticable.
