 - 19.50 Cross Gulch, 40 Ws. wide, course N. 60° E. and ascend.
 - 57.00 Top of Ridge bears N 30° E. 1° 30' W. and descends
 - 62.00 Cross Gulch, 30 Ws. wide, course N. 15° E. and ascend.
 - 80.00 Set Sand Stone 16 x 14 x 5 in. Stone mounted. 4 1/2 in. diameter at base by 2 1/2 in. height, for cor. to east. 25-26-35-36. from which bears, a Juniper 8 in. dia., N. 65° E. 44 Ws. dist. Juniper 13 in. dia., S. 55° E. 56 Ws. dist. Juniper 6 in. dia., S. 80° W. 50 Ws. dist. Nut Pine, 10 in. dia., N. 30° E. 31 Ws. dist.
