I carefully examined the adjustments of my solar  
compass to-day, particularly the latitude and revers-  
ing apparatus, and found them correct.

June. 8. 1881.

Before proceeding to subdivide this Tp., I made a  
change of  $5'$  minutes in the latitude arc of my  
solar compass by adding same to  
the reading previously given, and at noon verified  
same by observation on the sun. I also fur-  
ther tested instrument by reversing. I found the  
latitude to be  $38^{\circ} 30' N.$
