Before proceeding <sup>farther to earn the exterior of</sup> ~~to subdivide~~ this Tp., I made a  
change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my  
solar compass by adding same to  
the reading previously given, and at noon verified  
<sup>and corrected</sup> same by observation on the sun. I also fur-  
ther tested instrument by reversing. Found the  
latitude  $38^{\circ} 24' N.$
