I carefully examined the adjustments of my solar compass to-day, particularly the latitude and reversing apparatus, and found them correct.

July 24. 1881.

Before proceeding to subdivide this Tp., I made a change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by adding same to the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing. I found the latitude to be  $37^{\circ} 38' N.$
