Set a post,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long. 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for <sup>Standard</sup> Cor. to Tps. 20 S., R's 62. and 63 E., marked S. C. T. 20 S. on N. R. 63 E. S. 31 on E and R. 62 E. S. 36 on W. faces, with 6 notches on N. E. & W. faces, and raised a mound of stone  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, 5 ft. base, around post. Pits impracticable.
