East. on a true line on S. B. of Section 36.

Va. 15° 30' East.

14.00 Cross Wash 30 lks. wide, Course S. W. and ascend.

24.00 Top of bluff and enter table land.

36.00 Descend.

40.00 Set a basalt stone 15 x 12 x 10 ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{2}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{2}$  on N. face, and raised a mound of stone.
