Set a Lime stone  $14 \times 8 \times 3$  ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on N. face, dug pits,  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins., N. and S. of stone  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base.

Set a Lime stone  $19 \times 11 \times 7$  ins. 14 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 22 and 23 S., R's 5 E. and 5 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, dug pits,  $24 \times 18 \times 12$  ins. lengthwise on each line, N. S. E. and W. of stone, 6 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, 5 ft. base.
