40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam.  
12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on  
W. face, and raised a mound of stone  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  
 $3\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post. Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a post,  $4\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the  
ground, for Cor. to Tps. 21 and 22 S., R's 54 and  
55 E. marked T. 21 S. 31, on N. E. R. 55 E. S. 6,  
on S. E. T. 22 S. S. 1, on S. W. and R. 54 S. 36,  
on N. W. faces, with 6 notches on each edge, and raised  
a mound of stone  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post.  
Pits impracticable.
