Chains.

North on a true line between sections / - 6.

Va. $15^{\circ} 30'$ East.

Descend.

40.00 Set a Granite stone $28 \times 18 \times 10$ ins., 13' ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

80.00 Set a granite stone $28 \times 15 \times 12$ ins. 21 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 19 and 20 S. R's 58 and 59 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

Land rolling.

Soil $2\frac{1}{2}$ to 3 ft. rate

Undergrowth of bunchgrass.

July 11-1881

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Before proceeding to subdivide this Tp., I made a choice of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by adding same the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing. Latitude is $36^{\circ} 14' N.$
