S. B. Tp. 20 S., R. 52 E., Met. D. M.

W. on a true line on S. B. of Sec. 36.
Tva. $15^{\circ} 30'$ East.

29. 68 Intersect Boundary line, between California and Nevada, at a point which bears. 13. 73 chs. N. $45^{\circ} 1' W.$ from the 49th Mile post, and set a Post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, with marked stone (charred slate or quart of charcoal) 12 ins. in the ground, for Closing Cor. to Tps. 20 S., Rs. 52 & 53 E., marked C. C. T. 20 S. or S.; R. 53 E., S. 6 on E. and R. 52 E., S. 1 on W. faces with 6 notches on S., E. and W. faces, dug pits 2 $\frac{1}{4}$ x 1 $\frac{1}{8}$ x 12 ins. crosswise on each line, S., E. and W. of Post, 6 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 5 ft. base around Post. Land level. Soil 1st rate.
