W. edges and raised a mound of
stone. Pits impracticable.

Land mountainous.

Soil 3rd rate.

Dense undergrowth of greasewood,
bush and cactus.

West on a true line, on S. B. of Sec. 32,
Ta. $15^{\circ} 45'$ East.

40. 00 Set a Granite stone, $18 \times 18 \times 10$ ins.
12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec.
Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits
 $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. N. and S. of stone,
 $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound
of earth, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.
