40.00 Set a Stone, $14 \times 10 \times 5$ ins., 9 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. N. and S. of stone, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.

80.00 Set a Post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for Standard Corner to T_ps. 16 S., R. 50 + 51 E., marked S. C. T. 16 S. on N.; R. 51 E. S. 31 on E.; R. 50 E., S. 36 on W. faces, with 6 notches on N., E. and W. faces, dug pits $24 \times 18 \times 12$ ins., crosswise on each line, N., E. and W. of Post, 6 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 5 ft. base around Post. Land level.

Soil 1st and 2nd rate.

Dense undergrowth of sage and greasewood.
