From the Standard corner to T^{ps}.
16 S, R. 48 & 49 E., I run
West on a true line on S. B. of Sec. 36.
Ta. $15^{\circ} 45'$ East.

40. 00 Set a Basalt stone, $14 \times 9 \times 8$ ins.,
9 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor.
marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, dug pits
 $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. N. and S. of stone, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft.
dist., and raised a mound of earth
 $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base.

76. 05 Intersect Boundary between
California and Nevada, at a
point which bears 30. 85 chs.
N. 45° W. from the 465th Mile post and
set a Basalt stone $18 \times 12 \times 8$ ins.,
12 ins. in the ground for closing
corner to T^{ps}. 16 S., R. 48 & 49 E.,
marked C. C., with 6 notches on
S. E. and W. edges, dug pits
 $24 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. crosswise on each
line, S., E. and W. of stone and
