Before proceeding further with the exterior of this Tp., I made a change of 16 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass, by subtracting same from the reading previously given and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing. From the cor. to Tps. 18 & 19 S., Rs. 51 & 52 E., I run West on a true line, between Secs. 15 & 36. Var. 16° East.
