Ta. $15^{\circ} 45'$ East.

40.00 Set a Post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. on W. face, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. E. and W. of Post, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around Post.
