

E. B. Tps. 17 S., R. 48 E., Met. D. M.

Before proceeding further with the
 extensions of this Tps., I made a
 change of 5 minutes in the
 latitude arc of my solar compass,
 by subtracting same from the
 reading previously given and
 at noon verified and corrected
 same, by observation on the sun. I
 also further tested instrument by
 running.

From Standard Cor. to Tps. 16 S.,
 Ro. 48 & 49 E., I run 16. 10 ch. E.
 and set a Basalt stone, 16x11x10 ins.,
 11 ins. in the ground, for closing
 corner to Tps. 16 S., Ro. 48 & 49 E.,
 marked C. C. with 6 notches on
 each edge; dug pits 24x18x12 ins.
 crosswise on each line, S., E. & N.
 of stone, 6 ft. dist. and raised
 a mound of earth, 2 1/2 ft. high,
 4 1/2 ft. base,
