marked T. 28 N. S. 30 on N. E., R. 68 E., S. 31
on S. E., S. 36 on S. W. and S. 30 on N. W. face,
with / notch on S. and 5 notch on E. edges;
dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins. in each Sec., $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist.,
and raised a mound of earth 2 ft. high, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base
around post.
