

N. B., T. 26 N., R. 68 E., Mt. D. M.

North on a true line between sections 1-6.

Va. $16^{\circ}30'$ East.

Descend.

31.00 Cross Gulch, 4 lks. wide, Course East and ascend.

40.00 Set a Trachyte stone $30 \times 12 \times 10$ ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

A Juniper $1/4$ ins. diam. bears $N. 60^{\circ} E.$ 85 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.A Juniper $1/8$ ins. diam. bears $N. 1/4 N.$ 64 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.80.00 Set a Trachyte stone $34 \times 12 \times 10$ ins. 18 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 26 and 27 N. R's 62 and 63 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
