Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam.

N. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E. and W. of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base around post.

A Juniper 30 ins. diam. bears N. $46\frac{1}{2}$ E. 40 lks. dist. from which marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

Intersect the 6th Standard Parallel North at a point 27-41 chs. West. of the Standard Cor. to Secs. ~~and~~ . T. 31 N. R. 62 & 63 E. at which point I.

Set a post, $4\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for Closing Cor. to Tps. 30 N., R's 62 and 63 E. marked C. C. T. 30 N. R. 63 E. S. 6, on E. and R. 62 S. 1, on W. faces, with 6 notches on S. E. & W. faces, dug pits, 24 x 18 x 12 ins. crosswise on each line, S. E. & W. of post, 6 ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, 5 ft. base, around post.
