North on a true line between sections

1-6.

Va. 16' 30' East.

Descend.

40.00 Set a Trachyte stone $16 \times 14 \times 8$ ins., 10 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

from which

A Cedar 8 ins. diam. bears N. 65° W. 35 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

A Cedar 12 ins. diam. bears N. 14° E. 17 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

45.00 Cross Gulch, 5 lks. wide, Course N. N. and ascend.

80.00 Set a Trachyte stone $30 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. 2/3 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 27 and 28 N. R's 59 and 60 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

A Pine 12 ins. diam. bears S. 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 16 lks. dist. marked T. 27 N. R. 60 E., S., 6 B. T.

A Pine 8 ins. diam. bears N. 19° N. 41 lks. dist. marked T. 28 N. R. 59 E., S., 36 B. T.
