Chains.

North on a true line between sections 31 + 36

East. Va. $16^{\circ} 30'$ East.

Ascend.

18.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. 50° W. + S. 50° E. and descend.

39.00 Cross Gulch, 4 lks. wide, Course West and ascend.

40.00 Set a line stone $22 \times 10 \times 6$ ins., 15 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits

impracticable.

from which

A Juniper 10 ins. diam. bears N. 85° E. 28 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

East. A Juniper 10 ins. diam. bears N. 71° W. 14 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.

65.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. 76° W. + S. 76° E. and descend.

80.00 Set a line stone $22 \times 18 \times 19$ ins. 15 ins. in the ground for Cor. to Secs. 30-31-32-36 marked with / notch on S. and 0' notch on E. edges and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

A Juniper 14 ins. diam. bears N. 63° E. 47 lks. dist. marked T. 28 N. R. 60 E., S. 30 B. T.
