Chains.

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tp., I made a change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by adding same to the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing. Thence

From the Cor. to Tps. 27 & 28 N. Rs. 58 & 59 E

I run East on a random line on N. B. of Tp.

Va. $16^{\circ} 30'$ East,

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 5 miles 79.37 chs. I arrive at a point 1/4 lks. North of Cor. to Tps.

27 & 28 N. Rs. 59 & 60 E. from which corner I run $N. 89^{\circ} 50' W.$ on a true line between sections 1 & 36

Va. $16^{\circ} 40'$ East.

Descend.

36. 00 Cross Gulch, 5 lks. wide, Course $N. 70^{\circ} W.$ and ascend.

41. 00 Set a Trachyte stone $33 \times 16 \times 12$ ins., 24 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on N. face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.

from which

A Pine 8 ins. diam. bears $S. 86^{\circ} E.$ 24 lks. dist. marked $\frac{1}{4}$ S. B. T.
