Chains.

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Twp.,
I made a change of 7 minutes in the latitude arc
of my solar compass by subtracting same from
the reading previously given, and at noon verified and
corrected same by observation on the sun. I also fur-
ther tested instrument by reversing. *Thence*

from meander corner, on edge of dry bed of Lake 24A
which is a post in mound of earth, and 24.10
chains North of cor to secs. 7, 12, 13 + 18

Run North on a true line bett secs 7 + 12

around post.
