Chains.

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tp.,
I made a change of 7 minutes in the latitude arc
of my solar compass by subtracting same from
the reading previously given, and at noon verified and
corrected same by observation on the sun. I also fur-
ther tested instrument by reversing. Thence

From meander corner, on edge of dry bed of Lake ^{24A}
which is a post in mound of earth, and 24.10
chains North of cor to secs. 7, 12, 13 & 18

Run North on a true line bet sec 7 & 12

In dry bed of Lake

Variation $17^{\circ}36'$ East

15.90 Set a post 3 ft long 3 ins diam 12 ins in
the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. marked $\frac{1}{4}$
S. on N. face, dug pit 18x18x12 ins.,

N. $\frac{1}{2}$ S. of of post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft dist., and
raised a mound of earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft high,
