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Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tp.,
I made a change of 13 minutes in the latitude arc
of my solar compass by subtracting same from
the reading previously given, and at noon verified and
corrected same by observation on the sun. I also fur-
ther tested instrument by reversing. *Thence*

From meander cor, which is a cottonwood
post in earth mound, and which is 11.40
chs North from cor to secs 13, 18, 19 & 24
Run North between secs 13 & 18 on a true line
Variation 17° East

00.50 Leave greasewood and grass enter dry bed
of ^{lower} Carson Sink bet. E. & W.

28.60 Set a post $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft long, 3 ins diam 12 ins in
the ground for $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ 5 on
N. face, dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins N. of post
post $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft dist, and raised a mound of
earth $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft high, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft base around post.
