Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam.

12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on N. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E. and W. of post 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post.

Set a post, 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 22 and 23 N. R's 29 and 30 E. marked T. 23 N. S. 31 on N. E. R. 30 E. S. 6 on S. E. T. 22 N. S. 1 on S. W. and R. 29 E. S. 36 on N. W. faces, with 6 notches on each edge and pits, 24 x 18 x 12 ins., lengthwise on each line. N. S. E and W. of post, 6 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 2 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, 5 ft. base around post
