From the ^{meander} Cor. between Sect. 4 & 33 which is a post in mound of earth and 1/4 cor between Secs 4 & 33 I run East. on a random line on S. B. of Tp.

Va. 17° 30' East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 3 miles 4019 chs. I arrive at a point 30 lks. South of Cor. to Tps, 21 & 22 N. Rs. 29 & 30 E. from which corner I run

S. 89° 56' W on a true line between sections 1 & 36

In dry bed of lake Va. 17° 30' East.
