## Chains.

North on a true line between sections 1-6.

Va. 170° East.

Descend.

15.00 Cross Gulch, 3 lks. wide, Course 1.86 N. and ascend.

27.00 Top of hill bears E. & N. and descend.  
into Valley.

40.00 Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam.

12 ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  S. on  
W. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., E. and W. of  
post 5 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist. and raised a mound of earth 1 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft.  
high, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base around post.80.00 Set a trap stone 14 x 13 x 13 ins. 10 ins. in  
the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 21 and 22 N. R's 40 and  
41 E., marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a  
mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
