Chains.

Before proceeding further with the exteriors of this Tp., I made a change of 5 minutes in the latitude arc of my solar compass by adding same to the reading previously given, and at noon verified and corrected same by observation on the sun. I also further tested instrument by reversing. latitude 39° 33' N.

Thence From the Cor. to Tps. 23 & 24 N. Rs. 40 & 41 E

I run South on a random line on N. B. of Tp.

Va. 17° 30' East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile, and at 6 miles 0.55 chs. I arrive at a point 54 lks. East of Cor. to Tps,

22 & 23 N. Rs. 40 & 41 E. from which corner I run N. 4' W. on a true line between sections 31 & 36

Va. 17° 30' East.

Set a post 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam.

12 ins. in the ground, for 1/4 Sec. Cor., marked 1/4 S. on N. face, dug pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of post 5 1/2 ft. dist., and raised a mound of earth 1 1/2 ft. high, 3 1/2 ft. base around post.
