North on a true line between sections 1 - 6,  
Va.  $17^{\circ} 30'$  East.

## Ascend.

- 9.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. N. + S. E. and <sup>along East</sup> descend.
- 40.00 Set a granite stone  $23 \times 16 \times 11$  ins., 18  
ins. in the ground, for  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor., marked  $\frac{1}{4}$  on  
face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits  
impracticable.
- 47.00 A Spring, bears West 11 chs. dist.
- 60.00 Top of Ridge, bears N. N. + S. E. and descend.
- 69.00 Cross Gulch, 6 lks. wide, Course S. 71° E. and ascend.
- 80.00 Set a granite stone  $37 \times 21 \times 17$  ins.  $27$  ins. in  
the ground, for Cor. to Tps. 22 and 23. R's 37 and  
38 E. marked with 6 notches on each edge, and raised a  
mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
