40.00 Set a granite stone 19 x 14 x 11 ins., 1/2  
ins. in the ground, for 1/2 Sec. Cor., marked 1/2 on N.  
face, and raised a mound of stone. Pits  
impracticable.

80.00 Set a trap stone 16 x 13 x 8 ins. 10 ins. in  
the ground for Cor. to Secs. 30-31-35-36 (marked  
with / notch on S. and 5 notches on E. edges and  
raised a mound of stone. Pits impracticable.
