R. 37 E., S. 6 on S. E.

T. 44 N., S. 1 on S. W. and

R. 36 E., S. 36 on N. W. face, with 6  
notches on each edge, with pits  
24 x 18 x 12 in. in each Sec.,

N., S., E. and W. of post, 10 ft. dist, and  
a mound of earth, 2 1/2 ft. high,  
5 ft. basal around post—

From

North on a random line, bet. Secs. 31 and 36.

Var. 17° 45' East.

Along level valley.
