with earth. The post having greatly decayed, I reestablish Cor. by setting a Volcanic stone $26 \times 18 \times 13$ ins., 20 ins. in the ground alongside post, marked S. E. with 6 notches on N., E. and W. edges and rebuilt mound to be 2 1/2 ft. high, 5 ft. base around post. —

Thence I run

North on a random line on E. B. of Tp. Va. $18^{\circ} 20'$ East.

I set temporary corners at every half mile and at Cor. 1, 10 chs., I arrive at a point 7.45 chs. East of Cor. to Tps. 46 and 47 N., R. 36 and 37 E., which is a post, 4 ft long, 4 ins. square, 12 ins. in the ground, marked
T. 47 N., D. 31 on N. E.
R. 37 E., D. 6 on S. E.
