R. 35 <sup>and</sup> 36 E., I run  
North on a random line, bet. Secs. 31 <sup>and</sup> 36,  
Cva.  $18^{\circ} 25'$  East.

Set temporary  $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec. Cor.

79.86 To a point 121 lks. W. of old Cor. to  
Secs. 20, 30, 31 <sup>and</sup> 36, which is a  
post in an earth mound. The post  
being greatly decayed, to reestablish  
Cor., I set a Volcanic stone,  $20 \times 10 \times 8$  ins,  
5 ins. in the ground, marked with 1  
notch on S. and 5 notches on N. edges,  
alongside of post, dug pits  $18 \times 18 \times 12$  ins.  
in each Sec.,  $5\frac{1}{2}$  ft. dist., and raised  
a mound of earth 2 ft. high, 4 ft.  
base.

Thence I run

S.  $5^{\circ}$  W. on a true line, bet. Secs. 31 <sup>and</sup> 36,  
Cva.  $19^{\circ} 15'$  East.
