North on a random line, bet. Decs. 1st and 6th.

Var. $18^{\circ} 30'$ East.

To a point 8 lks. E. of old $\frac{1}{4}$ Sec. Cor., which is a 'Volcanic stone, $12 \times 10 \times 4$ ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on 'W. face, in a small earth mound. I enlarged mound to $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. in height, $3\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base and dug pits $18 \times 18 \times 12$ ins. E. and W. of stone, $5\frac{1}{2}$ ft. dist.

The return course is therefore S 7° E.

To a point 20 lks. E. of old Cor. to Tpo. 47th and 48th N., R. 35th and 36th E., which is a greatly decayed Willow post in a small earth and stone mound. To reestablish Cor., I set a 'Volcanic stone $26 \times 12 \times 4$ ins., 19 ins. in the ground, marked with 6 notches on each edge and raised a mound of stones. Pits impracticable.

The return course is therefore S 10° E.
