I set my instrument at the Cor. to Tps. 41+42 N. Rs. 69

+70 E. I took the latitude and found it to be 41°

28' N. I carefully examined all the adjust-

which is a post 4 ins square firmly
set in the ground marked T42 N S31
on N.E. R 70 E S 6 on S.E. T41 N S1 on
S.W. and R69 E S36 on N.W. Faces
with 6 notches on each edge and
pits 24 x 18 x 18 N.E. & S.W. of post
6 ft dist and mound of earth 2 1/2
ft high and 5 ft base around post
